360-Degree-Plaza in Hall 12

This new concept focusses on specialists from the fields process optimization, E-commerce, omnichannel marketing, sustainability, logistics, and staff. This new service provider platform is an innovative hybrid format which connects the fair presentation in hall 12 with a digital 365-day presence and extends the M.O.W. range of exhibitors by relevant service providers of this industry.

Extended Upholstery Offer

The exhibitors offer in the so-called "upholstery board" in hall 20 and 21 a new input for assortments and advertising for all sales channels. This year not only national but also international companies such as Nicoletti, Man



Wah, Romessa, Puszman, Atlantic, and Spin will present themselves as an alternative to the proven manufacturers.

New Structure and Allocation of Hall 5 and 6

Hall 5 and 6 in Messezentrum Bad Salzuflen will be given a new profile with an interesting broadly based range of exhibitors. Besides others, companies such as D+N with upholstered furniture and MCA with an additional area will be present at the fair.

Many Interesting New Exhibitors

In addition, you will also find in the other halls and product groups new interesting exhibitors such as Van Landschoot with their speciality of boxspring beds, or Composad, House Nordic and HMW Collection who enrich the offer of flat-pack furniture and Young Living at the M.O.W. So far almost 80 % of the space in Messezentrum Bad Salzuflen is already occupied.
